




Oban Cot

Instruction manual



IMPORTANT – Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain for future reference.

This Puggle Cot Bed conforms to BS EN 716:2017+AC:2019

Safety Instructions

IMPORTANT – Read the instructions carefully before use and keep for future reference.

- **WARNING:** A child's safety is your responsibility.
- **WARNING:** Be aware of the risk of open fire and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the cot.
- WARNING: Do not use the cot if any part is broken, torn or missing and use only additional
 or replacement parts obtained from the manufacturer or distributor.
- **WARNING:** Do not leave anything in the cot or place the cot close to another product, which could provide a foothold or present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e.g. strings, blinds/curtain cords etc.
- WARNING: Do not use more than one mattress in the cot.
- **WARNING:** Do not place this cot bed in close proximity to heat sources, windows and other furniture e.g. open fires, radiators, gas and electric heaters etc.
- The lowest cot base position is the safest. The base should always be used in the lowest position as soon as the baby is old enough to sit up.
- The thickness of the mattress used shall be such that the internal height (surface of the mattress to the upper edge of the cot frame) is at least 500mm in the lowest position of the mattress base and at least 200mm in the highest position of the mattress base.

 Maximum thickness of 100mm.
- All assembly fittings should always be tightened properly, checked periodically and the care should be taken that no bolts are loose, because a child could trap parts of the body or clothing (e.g. strings, necklaces, ribbons for babies' dummies), which could pose a risk of suffocation and strangulation.
- The safety of the cot could be adversely affected by fitting flammable drapes.
- To prevent injury from falls, when the child is able to climb out of the cot bed, the cot bed should be converted into a toddle bed.
- Recommended mattress size is 120 x 60cm and shall be such that the gap between the mattress and the sides and ends does not exceed 30mm.
- This Puggle Cot conforms to BS EN 716:2017+AC:2019.
- The Cot is suitable from birth, until the child is able to climb out of the cot.

WARNING! Assembly by an adult. Keep away from children until fully assembled. Keep children clear during assembly as pack contains small parts which may present a choking hazard.

Lay out the parts on a soft level surface and compare to the part/fixings checklist. Do not discard any packaging until you are sure that you have all the parts.

This bed is designed to be easily dismantled for storage or transportation.

Before Assembly

Before assembly, please ensure that you have read and understood the instructions. The carefully unpack our cot and ensure that all parts are present, please see parts list as follows.

Discard packaging in accordance with your local authority guidelines.

We advise that the cot should be assembled in the room where it is intended to be used, two person assembly is recommended. The cot should be assembled on a clean surface, free from any sharp objects that could mark or damage the product.


CAUTION: There are many small components used in the construction of this cot. These items should be kept out of reach of young children whilst assembling the unit.




2 Man assembly recommended, approximate build time 40 minutes.




Parts included with your Oban Cot are:

1	Front/Back Panel	2
2	Side Panel	2
3	Base Panel	1
Α	Barrel Nut	8
В	Bolt	8
С	Nut	4
D	Angled Bolt	4
Ε	Allen Key	1

A flat headed screwdriver may also be required when fastening the Barrel Nuts (A) (not supplied).


Assembling the Cot




- Insert the Barrel Nut (A) into the hole shown in the instruction step.
- Use a flat headed screwdriver (not supplied) to align the Barrel Nut (A).
- Insert the Bolt (B) and use the Allen Key (E) to screw into the Barrel Nut (A).




2. Repeat step 1. with the remaining Side Panel (2) using the Barrel Nut (A) and Bolt (B) and tighten with the Allen Key (E).

Care and Maintenance

- Scuff marks may be removed with a soft, damp cloth.
- Occasional use of furniture polish will maintain the finish of your cot.
- DO NOT use harsh or abrasive cleaners or bleaches on this product, as they may damage the finish.
- Periodically check all fixings to ensure they remain tight and tighten where required.
