

IMPORTANT! Your Snacky Booster Highchair may differ slightly from images shown above and throughout, as the images used are for illustration purposes only.

Your Snacky Booster Highchair is tested to comply with EN 16120:2012+A2:2016.

DO NOT use parts or accessories which are not approved or supplied by the manufacturer.

Safety Instructions

IMPORTANT - Read the instructions carefully before use and keep for future reference.

- **WARNING:** A child's safety is your responsibility, never leave the child unattended.
- **WARNING:** DO NOT allow other children to play unattended near the booster seat.
- **WARNING:** Adult assembly is required.
- WARNING: Ensure that all components are fitted securely into place and tightened where applicable before allowing your child to sit in the booster seat.
- **WARNING:** The harness must always be used and correctly fitted.
- **WARNING:** This product is suitable for use by one child at a time only.
- WARNING: DO NOT overload this product, maximum capacity is 15kg (approx. 36 months).

- **WARNING:** DO NOT use the booster highchair until your child can sit up unaided (approx. 6 months).
- **WARNING:** Always check the security and stability of the booster seat on the adult chair before use.
- **WARNING:** DO NOT install the product on highchairs. It is dangerous to use this product on an elevated surface.
- **WARNING:** DO NOT leave small objects on the booster seat which the child could swallow.
- WARNING: DO NOT use the booster seat on chairs in the vicinity of curtain cords, windows or heat sources.
- Never use the product as a swimming aid or floating chair in a swimming pool.
- When not in use, the booster seat must be kept out of the reach of children.
- Always use the booster seat on an adult chair with seat dimensions larger than the booster.
- Ensure that the adult chair with the chair mounted seat is placed in a position where the child is not able to use its feet to push against the table or any other structure as this can cause the tip over of the adult chair supporting the chair mounted seat.
- Ensure your child cannot push against the table or another surface as this could result in the booster seat tipping over.
- Never lift this product with your child sat in it.
- When adjusting, ensure that moving parts do not come into contact with the child's body.
- WARNING: DO NOT use this booster seat in motor vehicles.
- **WARNING:** DO NOT use this booster seat on stools or benches.
- Never use the booster seat on broken or unstable chairs, folding chairs, rocking chairs or chairs with armrests.
- Before fastening the booster seat to the chair, ensure that the floor and chair are perfectly
 horizontal; Never install the product on chairs which are positioned on sloping or uneven
 surfaces.
- DO NOT use the chair mounted seat if any part is broken, torn or missing.
- DO NOT use accessories or replacement parts other than those approved by the manufacturer.
- This product is intended for children able to sit up unaided (minimum 6 months) and up to 3 years old or a maximum weight of 15kg.
- Must be attached to adult chair with minimum dimensions: seat 30cm (W) x 31 (D), backrest: 43cm (H).
- This booster highchair conforms to EN 16120:2012+A2:2016.

Before Assembly


Before assembly, please ensure that you have read and understood the instructions. Then carefully unpack your booster seat and ensure that all parts are present, please see parts list as follows.



Assembling the Booster Seat

1. Unfold the Main Body (A) as shown in the diagram below, when fully unfolded it will click into


place.



2. Adjust the height position, according to the requirements of the child, press the height adjustment button on both sides of the Main Body (A) as shown below and then adjust the height accordingly. The seat will click to indicate the height position is locked into place.

3. To fold the legs back down press the height adjustment button on both sides of the Main Body (A) and fold the legs up flat until they sit flush in the frame as per the below far right

image.




4. To install the Snack Tray (B), simply insert the Snack Tray (B) into the corresponding slots on the Main Body (A) and then press down to click in place. Gently pull up on the Snack Tray (B) to ensure securely in place, pull the crotch guard down and slot into place on the Main Body (A). To remove pull the handle as shown below right out and lift the Snack Tray (B) up and away from the Main Body (A).


5. Ensure that the harness is correctly installed, by checking that the crotch strap is fed through the front slot on the Main Body (A) and is securely in place. The waist straps slot through the slots on either side of the backrest of the Main Body (A) and the metal 'C' shaped brackets should be fed through the straps to secure in place as shown in the images below. Gently pull on the harness to ensure correctly installed.



6. To secure the harness push the waist straps into the crotch buckle and the harness will click to indicate locked into place. Gently pull on the waist straps to ensure securely in place. The waist straps can be adjusted to suit the child by tightening or loosening accordingly.


WARNING: Correct and secure fit of the waist straps, will allow for 2 finger width.

7. To remove simply press the buckle and release the straps accordingly.






8. To mount the booster seat on an adult chair, attach the Safety Straps (C) to the Main Body (A). Feed one of the Safety Straps (C) on the backrest through the 'C' shaped metal bracket at the rear of the backrest on the Main Body (A) and the remaining Safety Strap (C) feed through the guide on the base of the Main Body (A) as shown below left. Loop the Safety Straps (C) around the adult chair on which to be mounted and then secure the buckles in place, tighten the straps where required. Gently pull on the main body, as a secure fit on the adult chair should allow little or no movement.



9. To fold, remove the booster seat from the adult chair and then remove the Safety Straps (C) from the Main Body (A) and then secure the Safety Straps (C) away safely. Press the fold button as shown below on either side of the Main Body (A), then fold the backrest forward until fully folded as shown below right.





Care and Maintenance

Cleaning

- Clean the plastic parts with a soft damp cloth.
- DO NOT use harsh or abrasive cleaners or bleaches on this product, as they may damage the product.
- If the booster seat comes into contact with water, dry the metal parts to prevent the formation of rust.

Maintenance

- Cleaning and maintenance should be carried out by an adult, do not allow a child to do this unless supervised and correct instruction has been provided.
- Periodically check all fixings to ensure they remain tight and tighten where required.
- DO NOT use this product if any part is broken, torn or missing and use only spares provided by the manufacturer.
- If parts become stiff or difficult to operate, ensure dirt is not the cause, then try a light application of a silicon lubricant, ensuring it penetrates between the components. Regular lubrication of moving parts will extend the life of your product and make opening and folding easier.
- After exposure to damp conditions, dry off with a soft cloth and leave fully open in a warm environment. Storing damp will encourage mildew to form.
- Store in a dry place.
- DO NOT leave in sunlight for prolonged periods as some colours may fade.
